



Deer Season Safe Driving Tips

- **Be observant! Look for deer-crossing signs showing areas where deer frequently travel**
- **Be alert. A deer standing near a roadside may suddenly run across the road. Slow down & use your horn to scare the deer**
- **Look for groups. If you see one deer crossing the road ahead, more are likely to follow**
- **Never swerve! Instead, slow down & brake. Swerving can cause you to lose control of your vehicle and strike other vehicles or object along the roadway**
- **Buckle up & do not speed. This will increase your reaction time**
- **Use high-beams for greater visibility**
- **AAA reminds you to be vigilant no matter what road you travel**
- **Do not try to move a deer. An injured deer may panic & injure you
